Title: Comanche Workbook – deep dive, Part 1
with Mike Neuman

This ComancheZOOM is Part 1 of Mike Neuman's presentation on his Comanche Workbook training tool. It is intended to be used by instructors and students when training or transitioning to Comanches. The workbook is patterned on the very successful Cirrus training program which has made a tremendous improvement in their safety record. Mike shares his workbook through a link on NortheastComanche.Org and also through a note in this week's Chat window.

In Part 1 Mike covers the general information, limitations and emergency procedures as found in a typical Comanche POH. He uses a question-and-answer format, asking for information about a specific value or task sequence, with a blank to fill in the answer as found in the POH. He uses a Comanche 250 as the example model, and comments on how a particular value might vary for different models and gross loadings.

The Zoom brought out many comments by those in attendance, including CFI/II's and long-time Comanche pilots. Their wisdom helped explain the various answers and expand the topic to other Comanche models.
