Title: **CO Detector and Transitioning Review**

This Zoom begins with a report on the use of a Forensics Detector to find alarming levels of carbon monoxide (CO) in a Comanche 250 – what levels were found, what actions reduced the reported levels, finding the sources, and post repair – plus other pilot's comments.

This is followed by a review, segment by segment, of the excellent presentation by George Richmond (5/29/22 Zoom) on transitioning to a high-performance complex aircraft. The original Zoom ran long, and a number of viewers had to drop out at 9:00 PM EDT. We were also not able to stop for comments or questions between the presentation segments. This Zoom attempted to address those leaving early by reviewing the later segments, and to plan to pause between segments for comment or questions.

The approach resulted in a wealth of Comanche knowledge expressed by those attending, but, once again, the clock ran out before we finished. There is plan to pick up where we left off at a later date.
