Topic: **Windy.com - another option for flight weather planning**
with Mike Neuman and Pete Morse

First we will get a preview of next week's ComancheZOOM presentation by Mike Neuman on his Comanche Workbook. This tool is intended to be used by instructors and students when training or transitioning to Comanches. The workbook is patterned on the very successful Cirrus training program which has improved their safety record tremendously. Next Pete Morse will walk us through the Windy.Com website utility. This is a very useful tool for forecast weather planning. What can you expect along your route today or in the days ahead? Where are areas worth avoiding? How about cloud cover and ceilings? What are the current MeTars and TAF's along the way?

Pete will use the website to plan a number of flight scenarios as examples. While this is not intended to be a deep-dive training session, you should end up with a good idea of what's available and enough knowledge to explore on your own.
