

ComancheZOOM for May 13, 2021 General Discussion

Tonight's ComancheZOOM was a general discussion of several topics.

Pete Morse introduced the Comanche Neighborhood concept as envisioned by Bill Cunniff. Bill is a longtime member of the ICS, joining in 1975 with member number 609. He is very aware of the Comanche Spirit which existed through those early years. His idea is to create local groups of Comanche pilots who could socialize with each other and support any member who has a need such as mechanical questions or relocating their Comanche.

Next, we talked about two fly-ins scheduled for the following weekend, one a Neighborhood gathering at Osceola WI, hosted by Patrick Lee, and the other an Armed Forces Day fly-in at Ellenville NY, hosted by Dwight Coombe.

Talk continued about other fly-ins happening in the mid-west, southwest, and Florida, each enforcing the idea of a Comanche Neighborhood.

Finally, CJ demonstrated the database program under development to access geo-mapped locations of Comanche pilots worldwide. This program was received with great enthusiasm by those in attendance and will be the subject of a future ComancheZOOM.
