This presentation includes:

- Flight Planning (Weight and Balance, Weather, Fuel Considerations, Routing, Notams, Airport information, Interface with panel avionics, ADSB, Making notes on Enroute Charts and Approach Plates, Filing the Flight Plans, etc)
- Flying with ForeFlight (Departure Procedures, Enroute Weather, Traffic, SUA, Changes to Routing, Determining Fuel stops, etc)
- Approaches (Arrival Procedures, Managing Approach Plates and other Airport Information, flying the Arrival and Approach Procedures, Using the Airport diagrams for taxi, etc),
- Miscellaneous (Pilot Information, Plane Information, Configuring Foreflight, Storing Documents, etc)

Much time was spent showing the many features available in this Pro version of ForeFlight. They greatly enhance those found in the basic version. Tips were also mentioned to get a reduced cost.
