Topic: Electronic Logbooks: What, Why, How, and When?

Speaker: Eric Berman

Brief Description:

This Zoom is a repeat and deeper dive in the material originally presented in the Dec 8, 2022 ComancheZOOM. Eric Berman is the developer of MyFlightBook and begins this Zoom with a review of the various reasons to go with an electronic logbook. He then moves on to demonstrate what the new features are, how to use them, why do they enhance safety and utility for aircraft, pilots and insurance policies alike, as well as providing record security, backups, future-proofing, and compatibility.

Electronic records are recognized by the FAA as fulfilling the requirements for pilot history. The format is basically a spreadsheet style database stored in the cloud. MyFlightBook provides an amazing and powerful means to access and manipulate that data from an iPhone, Android or PC, either live or at a later time.

Eric also demonstrated some of the analytical tools available with his MyFlightBook app – things like histograms of types of flights, flight hours by day of the week, etc. Numerous possibilities you might find using Excel or other spreadsheet programs.
