From project plane to AirVenture Lindy - part 1

In 2022 Francois Marquis was awarded the coveted Lindy Award at the Oshkosh AirVenture for his PA30 Twin Comanche restoration. This award is the top of the top. It is given to the best across all types, all divisions, in category, and is recognized worldwide as the ultimate recognition of aircraft craftsmanship.

Francois is an engineer, a perfectionist, Canadian aerobatic champion, and Canadian ATP holder. In this 2-part Zoom he takes us through the restoration process of his PA-30, for example from painstakingly



creating a scale CAD model that included EACH RIVET in order to produce the perfect spectacular paint design, to repairs, innovations, seat design, and then from materials to ergonomics to colors to (of course) the panel design.

Francois started when he bought the plane - but he called this his Covid project as Covid created a 2-year timeframe where he knew he could commit to do major work. This passionate endeavor took him well over 5000 hours to accomplish. Francois did not start out to create a Lindy winner but to create a beautiful and functional twin Comanche, yet this is his second Oshkosh award, winning his first in 1994 with his Lancair.
