

September 30, 2021 ComancheZOOM – Review of the NeCT AGM meeting at the Georgetown fly-in

This was basically an Open Mic ComancheZOOM to go over the topics reported at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Northeast Comanche Tribe. There were four major areas of project efforts discussed: Camaraderie, Knowledge, Representation, and Group Buys. Each area was broken down and listed on the whiteboard.

The first group consists of the many social activities, the chances to get together and share ideas. Activities like the fly-ins, or ComancheTown, and the quickly developing Comanche Neighborhood program. CJ also mentioned the MAP utility under development to quickly find nearby Comanche owner/pilots and services (topic of a future ComancheZOOM).

The second group deals with sharing the group knowledge of Comanches through the ComancheZOOMs and specific training opportunities for pilots, new and not so new, and for future trainers.

The third group is about developing a working relationship with the government agencies (FAA etc) and with other organizations (AOPA, EAA etc)

The last group is a report on the many group buys, both completed and ongoing. This discussion also went on to further talk about the “hard to find” parts list of earlier Zooms.

Some members brought up problems they have had with autopilot installs. This topic will be covered in another ComancheZOOM very soon, as will the topic of insurance.
