Nor'Easter News



Lot's of great things are happening with the Northeast Tribe and ICS as a whole. Our website and yearly fly-in schedule has become the model for other Tribes. The use of an online registration form is also being tried. Mailing lists, created from the ICS website's Pathfinder database, allow us to reach Tribe members directly with news and information, and have broadened our ability to communicate.

The NE Tribe has had a great response to the pilot training of CPPP and CPTP. While many have attended, there are still many more that could benefit. We strongly encourage everyone to participate in this Comanche specific program, becoming a more knowledgeable, better skilled and safer pilot. The 2017 fly-in schedule is listed below, and has a couple of new items along with some of the yearly favorites.

- The April fly-in is a weekend long event centering on New Bern, NC. We will meet on Friday night in New Bern, departing Saturday morning for a stop at First Flight NC, then on to lunch at Ocracoke Island on the outer banks. After another night in New Bern we will fly to Carthage NC for the best BBQ in the area.
- June is our return to Parlin Field in Newport NH to participate in their Airport Day. This has been a great fly-in with lots of people, a delicious barbeque, and an opportunity to conduct EAA Young Eagles flights. As of this time the date has yet to be set. June is also the month for the ICS Convention in Cleveland.
- In August we are trying to set up an extended weekend tour of eastern Canada. Ideas include Yarmouth NS, Summerside PEI, Quebec City, Montreal and Ottawa. Details are being worked out with the help of local ICS members and will be communicated to the membership when ready.
- Although not an official ICS-NE fly-in, October 6-7 is the APOA Regional Fly-in at Groton CT. Two days of seminars, displays and pilot talk right in our own back yard.

With the ICS Convention in June we need to nominate and elect our NE Tribe officers for 2017-2018. There is <u>Nomination Form</u> on our ICS-NE website for anyone who wishes to nominate someone (or to volunteer) for an office. The current officers have done an excellent job, but it would be good to get in some new blood. In May and electronic ballot will be posted on the website with the slate of nominees for election by the Tribe membership.
