

Notes from the Northeast Comanche Tribe Election Committee

As early as 2015 statements were made regarding the sanctioning and processing of Tribe election, and more made several times since then. These statements have been made by A Shiloh and Kate Burrows.

The statements clearly confirmed that the Tribes were responsible for sanctioning and processing the Election of Officers by the Tribe Members and that the ICS should not be involved.

Having established the background let's discuss the current situation, especially addressing the unsanctioned voting of A Shiloh earlier this year.

While in the processing for the Election of Tribe Officers for the 2019 Term, Shiloh initiated a counter election, using the ICS website, which the Northeast Comanche Tribe Members had previously voted to not use.


There is some question about the voting procedure that Shiloh used. The question as to whether all the Members who were legal to vote were informed of the election. Another question was a sudden addition of Members. A request for information as to the results was ignored. Therefore, at best his unsanctioned Election has a **CLOUD** over it and a question of **VALIDITY**.

The Northeast Comanche Tribe in response to an objection regarding the 2018 election developed an Election system that has been tested and proven to provide true and accurate results.

Why did Shiloh not use the Northeast Comanche Tribe's proven Election system?

This raises the question, why is the ICS, based on statements that the ICS should not be involved with Tribe voting, accepting and supporting a very questionable election?

Further, we understand that in addition to Voting problems outlined above, that two other Tribes have had irregularities which involved manipulating the votes so the Members chosen for office were denied being appointed. The voting process was serviced on the ICS Site.
