We have two busy airports to fly into in the coming days:

- This weekend, April 11 (or 13), Wilmington NC (KILM) for the Comanche Maintenance Assessment Clinic (MAC), hosted in her hangar by Rosemarie Williams.
- Next week, April 14-19 Sun 'N Fun at Lakeland FL (KLAL) for the 2026 Sun 'N Fun and ComancheTown festivities.

This week's Zoom plan is to refresh procedures involved with flying within these busy airspaces without damaging your paint or logbooks. If you are planning to fly in to either of these events you need to register. Both locations need to know who is coming.

The invitation PDF for Wilmington was attached to the Zoom invite. While the MAC event is the primary activity, there were also links to other activities in the area. Rosemarie and the tower folks need to know that you are coming. WINGS credit is approved.

Those flying to Sun 'N Fun will need to download the NOTAM (<https://flysnf.org/flying-in/notams/>) and follow its instructions. In tonight's Zoom we went over the arrival in a general way as time allowed. My own file of the NOTAM graphics for cockpit reference was also included with the Zoom invite. Don't forget to register for Sun 'N Fun and ComancheTown.

This coming week will be busy, with lots of opportunities for learning, friendship, and fellowship - in true Comanche Spirit.
