Topic: Electronic Logbooks: What, Why, How, and When?

Speaker: Eric Berman

Brief Description:

This Zoom closely follows the basics of a 2014 FAA WINGS presentation done at California's San Carlos airport but includes a lot of features and capability not even possible back then. Eric Berman is the developer of MyFlightBook and begins this Zoom with the various reasons to go with an electronic logbook. He then moves on to demonstrate what the new features are, how to use them, why do they enhance safety and utility for aircraft, pilots and insurance policies alike, as well as providing record security, backups, future-proofing, and compatibility.

Electronic records are recognized by the FAA as fulfilling the requirements for pilot history. The format is basically a spreadsheet style database stored in the cloud. MyFlightBook provides an amazing and powerful means to access and manipulate that data from an iPhone, Android or PC, either live or at a later time.
