**Topic: CO in the Cockpit – part 2**

The Zoom opened with a discussion about dealing with airport runways with varying amounts of snow cover – how much is too much, for takeoff or landing. Also mentioned were plowed snow banks at the runway or taxiway edges relative to the Comanche wings which are wide and low to the ground.

Dr Rosemarie Williams then presented the rest of her PowerPoint on CO poisoning, detection device myths vs truths, and reversible vs permanent effects. This was a continuation of the presentation from Jan 22, with FAA Wings credit.

Earlier questions on Dr. Koz's talk about his line of Forensic CO detectors and the engineering principles involved were brought up. These questions brought out many of the unit's features.
