**Topic: CO in the Cockpit**

The Zoom opened with a discussion about the experience a pilot had who went through an annual inspection where he was told his landing gear had to be re-rigged, at a cost of an additional 35 hours for two A&Ps. The plane had experienced zero problems after having the 1000-hr AD gear inspection 10 years previously. The A&Ps in attendance are now planning to create a check list for owners to use when communicating with their A&Ps

Robert Britt then discussed aircraft heater construction and CO leaks, and compliance with the Southwind Heater AD via the Harold Haskins AMOC <https://haroldhaskinsinc.com>

Dr Rosemarie Williams will presented a PowerPoint on the topic of CO poisoning, detection device myths v truths, and reversible vs permanent effects. There will be a repeat, in early February, to repeat the entire presentation, this time with FAA Wings credit.

Dr. Koz then talked about his line of Forensic CO detectors and the engineering principles involved. Questions from the attendees brought out many of the unit's features.
